She graduated in Electrical Engineering in 1996 at Università degli Studi di Cassino, Italy, and obtained the Ph.D. in Industrial Engineering in 2001 at the same university.

She was a Guest Scientist at the Technical Division of Fermi National Accelerator Laboratory (Chicago, USA) from December 1997 to February 1998.

From 1999 to 2005 she has been an Assistant Professor of Electric Power Systems at Università degli Studi di Cassino. From 2005 to 2014 she has been an Assistant Professor at Politecnico di Torino.

She is associate professor of Electric Power Systems at Politecnico di Torino (2014-present).

She taught in many courses at Università degli Studi di Cassino and at Politecnico di Torino. Currently, she is responsible of “Electrical Systems and safety” (B.Sc in Electrical Engineering) and of “Industrial electric systems” (B.Sc. in Management Engineering).

She co-authored 90 papers published in international journals and in the proceedings of conferences.

She co-authored of five book chapters (in English).

She participated in several EU 7th Framework Programme projects and National projects, and collaborated in the framework of many research contracts.

She is a member of the Editorial Board of the Journal “Energies” (publisher: MPDI) from 2017. She was co-Guest Editor of Special Issue: “Risk-Based Methods Applied to Power and Energy Systems”, Energies (publisher: MPDI) in 2017.

She has served as a member of the Technical programme committee of many international conferences in the field of electric power systems. She was also the Publications Chair for the 7th IEEE PES International Conference on Innovative Smart Grid Technologies - Europe, Torino, September 26–29, 2017.
